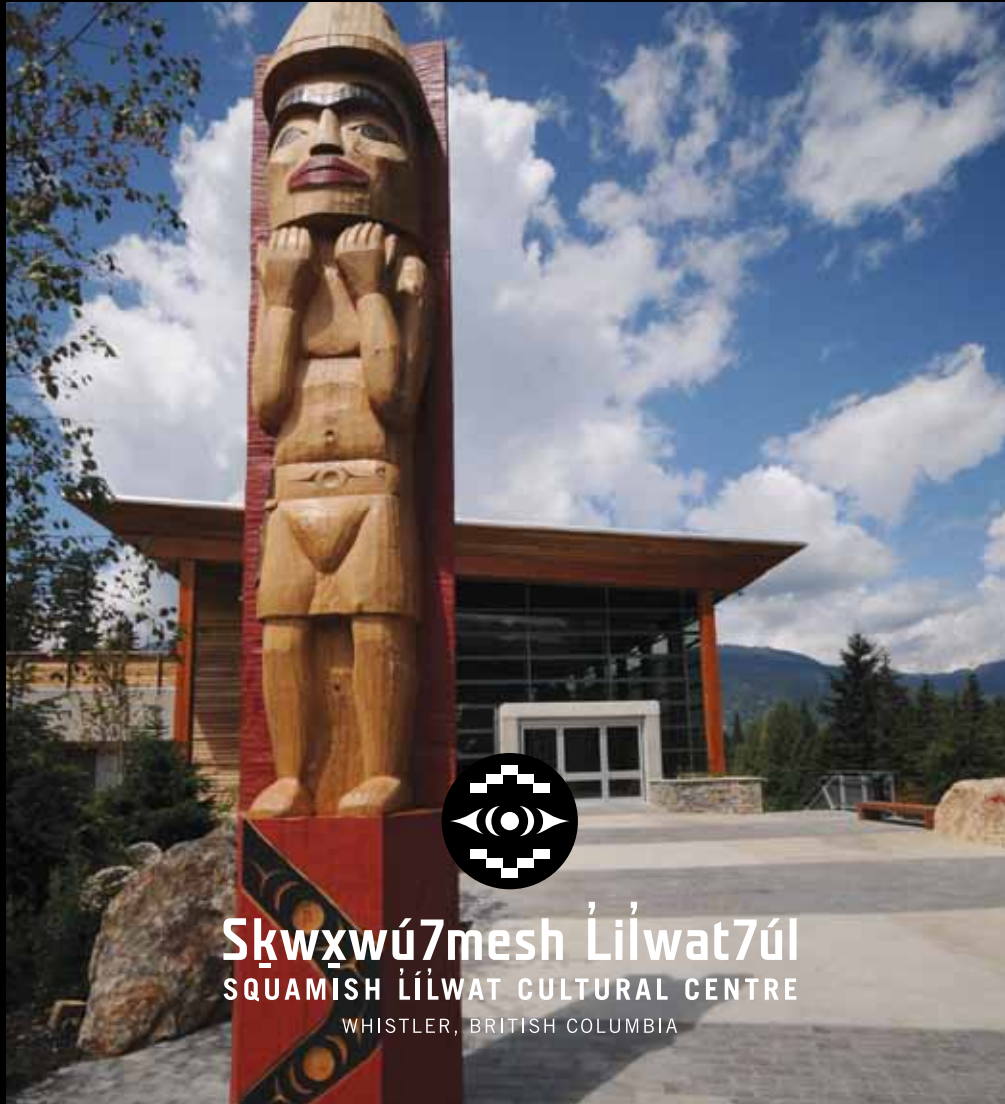

### HOSTS FROM TWO NATIONS

Meet our Squamish and Lílwat Ambassadors — take a guided or self-guided tour through our museum, exhibits, and contemporary galleries. Watch our spectacular 15 minute film showcasing our traditional and modern cultures.





View authentic **dugout canoes** carved from single old growth cedar trees. Journey through **interactive exhibits** that celebrate our traditions of **art, music, language, and ceremony** — past and present.

This architectural masterpiece, was built to resemble our traditional dwellings — a Squamish Longhouse and Lílwat Istken. Already a landmark, the building celebrates the unique culture of our two Nations.



### EXHIBITS & MUSEUM

View exhibits that explore our relationship to the land and objects that celebrate our art, music, and ceremony — past and present. View our sacred cultural treasures displayed in 'Class A' museum space. Touch screens and interactive panels showcase our languages, artifacts, and seasonal use of land and resources.

### FAMILY FUN

Engage in storytelling and make a traditional craft with your Squamish and Lílwat hosts.

### MOVIE

A 15 minute film provides a spectacular visual portrayal of Squamish and Lílwat traditional territories — featuring our languages, traditional practices and contemporary cultures.

Take your taste buds on a journey of discovery. Cozy up with a bowl of Squamish salmon chowder or hearty Lílwat venison chili. Enjoy the mountain and forest views from the Istken Hall.

### THE GIFTSHOP

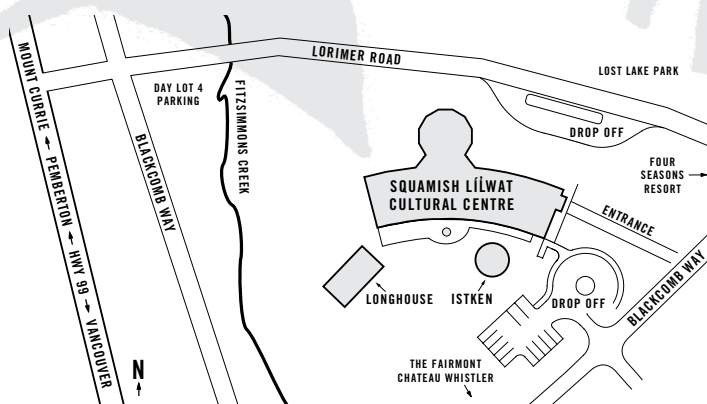
